EXPERIENCE & OTHER QUALIFICATION

Years of training in specialty or subspecialty plus post-training experience must be equal to or exceed seven (7) years.

Responsible To: Head, Section of Dermatology/Chairman, Department of Medicine

Basic Function: Responsible for evaluation and management of patients particularly in the field of dermatological diseases

PRINCIPAL DUTIES

CLINICAL

Provides high quality care and management of patients in this area of medicine.
Attends specialty clinic.
Provides consultative service as requested.
Shares on-call schedule for the Department of Medicine as needed.
Performs special procedures as required.

ADMINISTRATIVE

Participates in committees and other administrative functions as needed.
Follows all Hospital-related policies and procedures.
Performs other related duties as assigned.

RESEARCH

Participates in research activities

EDUCATION

Supervise fellows, assistant physicians and residents.
Actively participate in the training and teaching of residents and fellows in his area of expertise.
Actively participates in the educational activity of the Section
Actively participates in the educational activity of the Department of Medicine
Participates in patient education.

REQUIRED CREDENTIALS

EDUCATION
