
Total number of patients managed on this Clinical Pathway: 22

Summary:

Total number of patients who managed on this Clinical Pathway were 22 as the following:

Day	Explanation
On day one	(12) patients were successfully extubated
On day two	(2) patients were successfully extubated
On day three	(4) patients were successfully extubated
On day four	(3) patients were successfully extubated
On day six	(1) patient had pathway completed yet was successfully extubated

Findings:

- 1. Number of successfully extubated patients is 21 (95%)
- 2. The Clinical Pathway utilization was not fully completed by Respiratory Therapist this quarter.
- **3.** The ultimate outcome measure for this clinical pathway is that the patient will be extubated within five (5) days of initiating the pathway, for this quarter the average LOS for all the patients is 2 *Days*.
