


Predicting Successful Extubation Clinical Pathway Report

Clinical Pathway 1st Quarter Report 2017

Measures:

The Long-term outcome measure for this clinical pathway is all patient (85%) will be extubated within five (5) days from the initiation of the pathway.

Summary:

Total number of patients who managed on this Clinical Pathway were 28 as the following:

Day	Explanation
On day one	(19) patients were successfully extubated
On day two	(7) patient was successfully extubated
On day three	(2) patients were successfully extubated

Findings:

- 1. Number of successfully extubated patients is 28 (100%) out of 28.
- **2.** The Clinical Pathway utilization is unknown, the tracker form was not fully completed by Respiratory Therapist this quarter.

Follow up Action Plan:

- 1. The report to be shared with the respective Healthcare Provider/ Medical Quality Director / Clinical Pathway Coordinator
- 2. Encourage the Healthcare Providers to utilize the clinical pathway nurse champion as a resource for any clarifications.
- 3. The clinical pathway coordinator reinforce on the urgency of the compliance of the tracker form during monthly rounds.
- 4. A memo is initiated to HITA to build the pathway form in ICIS to facilitate the collection of data and generate a utilization report.
