Duration of the Program and Rotation System:

Four years of accredited training, it starts on 1st of October of each year. During the first two years, the resident is considered as a junior resident and the last two years as a senior resident. During these four years, the residents will rotate in the following subspecialties:

Rotation:

<u>Research Rotation:</u>

- If planning a research project; research proposal must be submitted in R1. A short research report and evaluation form to be completed at the end of the rotation.
- \circ No oncall will be taken during the rotation unless it coincides with the Eid holiday.
- o If no proposal was received, he/she will be assigned to Internal Medicine Rotation.
- The Resident must attend all departmental activities.

• Ambulatory Care Clinic Rotation:

- Needs to choose seven clinics / five days (at KFSHRC).
- Submission must be one month in advance; otherwise the chief resident will assign the clinics.

• Elective Rotation:

- If the resident is planning a research project, he/she should provide a proposal of his/her project four weeks in advance.
- A non-research elective can be taken in any hospital recognized by the Saudi Commission for Health Specialties.

• Rotations of Four Weeks:

• Resident is allowed to take maximum of 5 days during rotation which consist of 4 weeks e.g. (Neurology in R2, Oncology in R2,)
