



Measures:

The ultimate outcome measure for this clinical pathway is that all patient will be extubated within five (5) days from the initiation of the pathway.

Summary:

Total number of patients managed on this Clinical Pathway was 20 as follow:

Findings:

- 1. The number of successfully extubated patients is 20 (95%).
- 2. One patient was Trached post trail of extubation.
- 3. Pathway documentation compliance needed to be improved by all disciplines especially medical staff
- **4.** The Clinical Pathway utilization is unknown, the tracker form was not fully completed by Respiratory Therapist this quarter.

Follow up Action Plan:

- 1. The report to be shared with the respective Healthcare Provider/ Medical Quality Director / Clinical Pathway Coordinator
- 2. Encourage the Healthcare Providers to utilize the clinical pathway nurse champion as a resource for any clarifications.
- 3. The clinical pathway coordinator to reinforce the importance of utilization of the tracker form during monthly rounds.
