Data Collection Period: 01 July 2018 - 30 September 2018.


Units using the clinical pathway: SSCU-B,MICU-C and MICU-L10


Data Sources: Retrospective review of Clinical Pathways

Measures:

The ultimate outcome measure for this clinical pathway is that all patient will be extubated within five (5) days from the initiation of the pathway.

Summary:

Total number of patients managed on this Clinical Pathway was 20 as follow:

Day	Explanation
On day One	(3) patients were successfully extubated
On day Four	(2) patients were successfully extubated
On day Five	(1) patient was successfully extubated

Findings:

- 1. The number of successfully extubated patients is 6 (100%).
- 2. Pathway documentation compliance needed to be sustain by all disciplines especially medical staff

Follow up Action Plan:

- 1. The report to be shared with the respective Healthcare Provider/ Medical Quality Director / Clinical Pathway Coordinator
- 2. Encourage the Healthcare Providers to utilize the clinical pathway nurse champion as a resource for any clarifications.
