



Predicting Successful Extubation Clinical Pathway Report

Clinical Pathway 1st Quarter Report 2019 Data Collection Period: 01 January 2019- 31 March 2019 . Units using the clinical pathway: SSCU-B,MICU-C and MICU-L10 Data Sources: Retrospective review of Clinical Pathways Total number of patients managed on this Clinical Pathway: 7 . The utilization is unknown this quarter due to incompletion of the extubation log sheet (Tracker).

Measures:

The ultimate outcome measure for this clinical pathway is that all patients will be extubated within five (5) days from the initiation of the pathway.

Summary:

Total number of patients managed on this Clinical Pathway was 20 as follow:

Day	Explanation
On day Three	(1) patients was successfully extubated
On day Four	(3) patients were successfully extubated
On day Five	(3) patients were successfully extubated

Findings:

- 1. The number of successfully extubated patients is 7 (100%).
- 2. Pathway documentation compliance needed to be sustained by all disciplines

Follow up Action Plan:

1. The report to be shared with the respective Healthcare Provider/ Medical Quality Director / Clinical Pathway Coordinator

2. Encourage the Healthcare Providers to utilize the clinical pathway nurse champion as a resource for any clarifications.
