SUBJECT: COVID-19 PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES: RESTRICTIONS ON HOSPITAL ENTRANCES

In line with our efforts to ensure the safety of our patients and employees and to optimize infection control measures for COVID-19, a decision was made to restrict and control access to the hospital by temporarily closing the following hospital entrances starting on Thursday, 12 March 2020 at 7:35 a.m.:

- 1. Red carpet entrance at the main hospital
- 2. L1 Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Building main entrance
- 3. North Tower Building entrances (both north and west sides will be closed; east side will remain open)
- 4. King Abdullah Centre for Oncology and Liver Diseases (KACO&LD) Building Level 1 entrance at the west side (other entrances will remain open)
- 5. KCO&LD Level B1 and B2 (Parking Areas).

Furthermore, the following entrances will be closed and will be utilized by employees through door access only.

- 1. Medical Support Services Building (MSSB) entrance
- 2. Emergency Room B2 entrance
- 3. East Wing second gate
- 4. Outpatient Basement area

All open entrances will be equipped with:

- Adequate amount of hand sanitizers
- Nursing Team to do the initial visual screening and thermal checking for all individuals passing through these entrances
