In line with the KFSH&RC's efforts to protect its staff and patients against the spread of COVID-19, further steps will be taken this weekend (20-21 March 2020).

- All employees are requested to stay home and work from there on Sunday and Monday (22-23 March 2020). The current working schedule will resume on Tuesday, 24 March 2020.
- Clinical, Nursing and Medical staff to apply on call schedule.
- Clinics are to be converted to phone clinic, except "Day Medical Clinic", "Hemodialysis", and "Infusion Area" where treating physicians are responsible for assessing the need of those patients.

All Supervisors and managerial levels are requested to ensure that the urgent Hospital operations are not affected. Accordingly, scheduled appointments and surgical procedures and all other operations are to be rescheduled.

Due to the current situation, employees should be available at all times (including weekends), and report for work within thirty (30) minutes, when needed.
