
Data Collection Period: 01 April 2020 - 30 June 2020.


Units using the clinical pathway: MICU-L9 and MICU-L10 Data Sources: Retrospective review of Clinical Pathways

The ultimate outcome measure for this clinical pathway is that all patients will be extubated within five (5) days from the initiation of the pathway.

Summary:

Total number of patients managed on this Clinical Pathway were 15 as follow:

Day	Explanation
On day One	(6) patients were successfully extubated
On day Two	(4) patients were successfully extubated
On day Three	(3) patients were successfully extubated
On day Five	(2) patients were successfully extubated

Findings:

- 1. The number of successfully extubated patients is 15(100%).
- 2. Pathway documentation compliance needed to be sustained by all disciplines

Follow up Action Plan:

- 1. The report to be shared with the respective Healthcare Provider/ Medical Quality Director / Clinical Pathway Coordinator
- 2. Encourage the Healthcare Providers to utilize the clinical pathway nurse champion as a resource for any clarifications.
