Recently, we have noted that some Physicians' dictated reports were lost / not received and transcribed. After investigation, we found out that the system didn't deliver all reports back to Via-LOOK and ICIS. 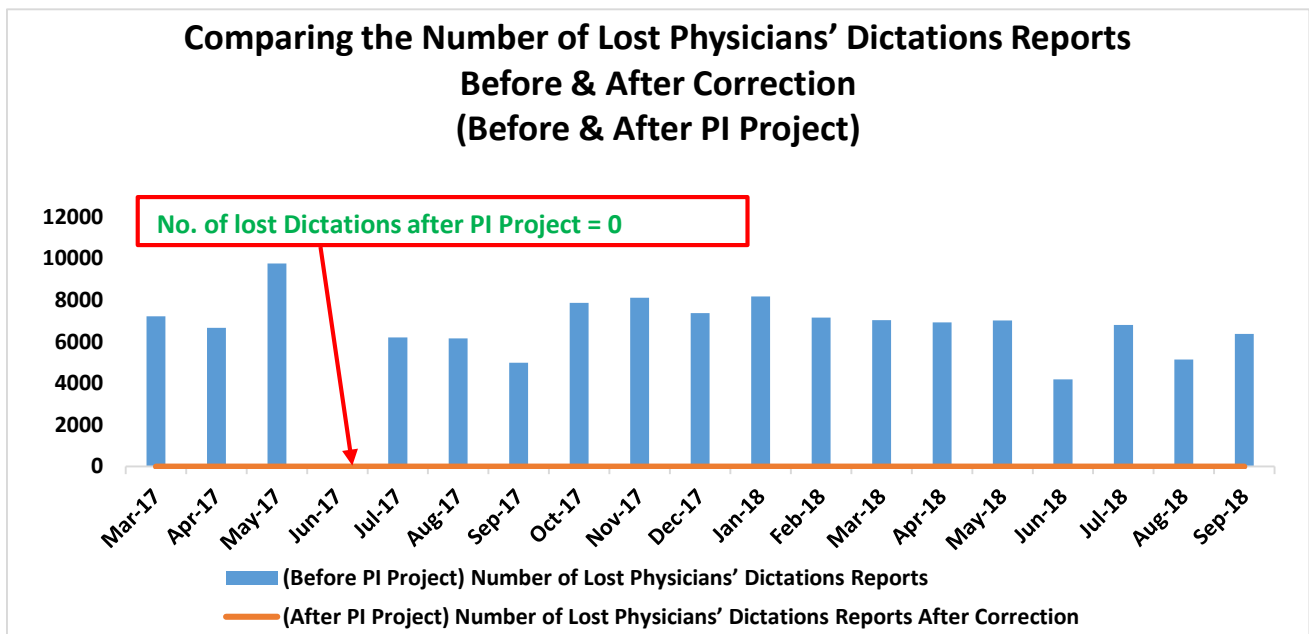
Interventions: Overview of key steps/work completed
