

Problem: Why the project was needed? As delay in commencing therapy for patients with cancers (specially advanced stages) are known to have unfavorable affects on overall and disease free survivals. For that reason, this project was selected to increase the percentage of patients' first encounter within two weeks of acceptance by pediatric oncology services (Solid Tumor and Leukemia/ Lymphoma section).		Aims: What will the project achieve?  To increase the percentage of patients' first encounter within two weeks of acceptance by pediatric oncology services from a baseline of 79% to 86% by December 31st, 2018 and to sustain the same practice for another six months

Interventions: Overview of key steps/work completed

- Develop a web-based patient management system for Non-Malignant Blood Disorders on Research Electronic Data Capture System (REDCap) to track newly-accepted patients at Pediatric Hematology / oncology services with a trigger set as ≤ 14 days for first encounter from acceptance date.
- Create Patients list's catalogued as "**Urgent Admissions**" and "**Outpatient Appointments**", which enabled real-time tracking to find beds or explore other outpatient options such as Marhaba clinic, Walk-in clinic etc.
