Problem: Why the project was needed?

Referred Out-Patients are waiting too long to be seen in Physical Therapy Clinic:

Acute cases from: 1-3 days
Subacute cases: 2-4 weeks
Chronic cases: 4 to 8 weeks

Consequently, acute/subacute patients were not timely receiving appropriate physio attention thus leading to chronic pain and problems. Adding to this problem, was the increased number of referrals for chronic patients who can be self-managing their conditions but utilizing number of slots which could otherwise benefit other acute patients.


