


SAFETY ALERT Medication Order Rejection

"Sharing Lessons Learned"


- △ Based on a recent incident, it was identified that some physicians were not aware of the medication order rejection sign in the power chart.
- △ The inpatient pharmacist can reject medication orders, whether or not they may reach the ordering physician to clarify/modify wrong medication orders promptly.
- △ Note: The order will remain in the active medication list marked with the rejection sign.
- △ Physicians need to customize the view to add "Notifications" to view the rejection sign and act upon it.

How to customize the view "add: notification":







Where to find the rejection sign:
